RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR VENDORS/DEALERS

1. All Borough Ordinances must be observed.
2. Vendors must agree to take full responsibility for persons, property and merchandise, and will not hold New Freedom Borough or New Freedom Lions Club organizers responsible for any loss, damage or injury to dealers' persons or property.
3. Alcoholic beverages, controlled substances, sale of firearms, martial arts weapons and pornographic materials are prohibited.
4. Most spaces are sized approximately 20'x25', some are 17'x25'. One vehicle per space, tables, pegs and poles to be inside perimeter.
5. Vendors are responsible for handling money and providing change to their own patrons.
6. Vehicles should be in place by 7:45 AM and stands open for sales at 8:00AM. No vehicles should be driven on the grounds after 7:45AM for safety reasons. Late arrivals should hand carry items to spaces. While we cannot expect to enforce vehicles remaining in their spaces until 2:00 pm, any such movement should exercise the greatest caution for safety reasons. Please locate yellow-shirted Lions for any emergency assistance.
7. Use of generators and electric cords has been prohibited in the past. Special permits will be granted for the betterment of patron experiences. If such a permit is desired, requests must be made in advance of space assignment. No other electric service will be available for safety reasons.
8. No grills, stoves, open fires, or cooking allowed on grounds or parking lots.
9. Refreshments and food rights are all reserved.
10. Vendors may set up at 6:00 AM. Coffee will be ready!
11. Each vendor is responsible for cleaning their space and placing their trash in the receptacles provided, including all empty boxes, bags and unsold items, before leaving.

13. Registration and Checks: make payable and mail to New Freedom Lions Club, P.O. Box 235, New Freedom, PA 17349, or give to any New Freedom Lions Club member. Payment may also be submitted via Pay Pal on the NFLC website Home page, and registration forms sent to the email address listed above. To use Pay Pal, go to [www.NewFreedomLionsClub.org](http://www.NewFreedomLionsClub.org) and press the donate button at the very bottom of the page. Add \$2 transaction fee to your calculated total and indicate that the money is for a Yard Sale Registration, or YSR.

15. NO REFUNDS for Inclement weather. The event will be held on the announced date, RAIN or SHINE. If any weather event should prevent the event from taking place, please accept our sincerest Thank You for your donation to the New Freedom Lions Club.

16. Prices for spaces and tables are listed on the Registration form.

17. Requests for specific spaces will be honored to our best ability (FCFS). Early entrants who have preference on space assignment are helpful in submitting requests for specific spaces. If you are not sure where you would like to be, please see the Site Map for things which you may wish to be near or far from. For example, Kids' playground and bounce house (if applicable) are near spaces 19 & 20, while food and music (if applicable) are available near the Band Stand and spaces #103, 112, "Y", and "Z". Portable ADA restrooms will be provided on the grounds near spaces #56, "V" and "X".

19. Vehicles must enter via School Alley off South Constitution Avenue. It may be easier to find by looking directly behind People's Bank on South Main Street in New Freedom.

20. Tables will be available for rent, but must be paid for in advance. \$9 for each 8' table or \$7 for each 6' table. Fees may be added to the registration and paid by check or Pay Pal. No tables will be available to request on the day of the event. Collateral (Driver's License) must be provided for rental tables upon setup, and will be returned when tables are returned.
